7.1.1 Measures initiated by the Institution for the promotion of gender equity and Institutional initiatives to celebrate / organize national and international commemorative days, events and festivals during the last five years

The courses that the institution has introduced demonstrate that it has implemented a number of measures in the curriculum to promote gender equity and awareness. For example, the Department of Humanities and Sciences offers a course called "Gender Sensitization," which aims to expose students to more egalitarian interactions between males and females, as well as information about some important biological aspects of gender.

The institute promotes gender sensitization through extracurricular activities such as workshops, seminars, guest lectures, street plays, poster exhibitions, counselling, and so on. "Self-defense training" was organised for the institution's female students. In order to ensure the safety and security of female students and employees, awareness campaigns on topics such as the value of human rights, the rights of women in domestic situations, and cyber security awareness campaigns are held on a regular basis.

In accordance with university institution grievance committee guidelines, the institution established the following committees: anti-ragging, students' disciplinary committee, women empowerment, SC/ST students welfare committee, and mentoring programme. The duties of these committees are listed on the institution's website, and information is also provided to students through orientation and induction activities.

The college provides employees and students with safety and security features such as CCTV surveillance throughout the campus and security personnel who monitor the campus around the clock. The institution has a dedicated counselling centre and an effective mentoring programme to support students' academic, emotional, social, and cognitive growth. Personal counselling is provided to students on a variety of levels. Boys' and girls' restrooms are in separate buildings. To ensure your safety, sanitary napkin vending machines are available in the restrooms. The institution also provides separate, well-equipped common rooms for boys and girls.
